- Bible schooling/training is preferred
- > Willingness to raise funds from a support base for their position

- > Communicating and Collaborating with key stake holders-staff, board of directors, supporters
- > Teaching the Bible and seeking to apply Biblical principles to all areas of camp ministry
- Overseeing operations of the camp ministry including the finances, upkeep of grounds, food service, program and counseling staff
- > Organizing and developing camp brochures, camper registrations and social media promotions
- > Developing a camp theme and Bible study material for each summer
- > Reaching out to local churches and para-church organizations to build relationships
- > Seeking ways to serve God with the resources He has granted VCBC
- > Dealing with conflict using principles found in scripture including Matthew 18:15-17
- > Possession of or willingness to obtain a CDL to drive the camp bus with required endorsements
- Knowledge and ability to perform basic maintenance functions is preferred
